MALAYSIA AIRLINES RESUMES FLIGHT OPERATIONS AT BANGKOK FROM 5 DEC 2008

Malaysia Airlines is resuming its flights between KLIA and Suvarnabhumi International Airport, Bangkok effective Friday, 5 December 2008.

“We are pleased with this development and thank the authorities for the fast restoration of flight operations at Suvarnabhumi airport. Tomorrow, 4 December 2008, we will operate our last flights MH782/3 into and out of U-Tapao. We will then resume our flights into and out of Bangkok with one daily flight initially effective 5 December 2008,” said Dato’ Tajuden Abu Bakar, Malaysia Airlines’ Director of Operations.

“Flight MH 782, using an Airbus A330-300 aircraft, will depart KLIA for Bangkok at 3.15pm and the return flight MH783 from Bangkok will depart at 5.10pm to arrive KLIA at 8.15pm. Based on customer demand, we will gradually restore our operations to four daily flights between KLIA and Bangkok,” he added.
