MEDIA STATEMENT FOR IMMEDIATE USE

This is the **latest** Sarawak Government's Policy Direction in regard to the global COVID-19 outbreak.

Since the COVID-19 outbreak, there is no known COVID-19 infection in Sarawak. To ensure Sarawak remains free of the disease, the following immigration policies are being enforced.

1. **All Foreigners (irrespective of nationalities)** who have been to **Mainland China, South Korea, Italy and Iran** in the past 14 days will be **REFUSED** entry into the state.
2. **All Malaysians (non-resident of Sarawak)** who have been to **Mainland China, South Korea, Italy and Iran** in the last 14 days are **strongly advised NOT to visit Sarawak**.
3. **All Sarawakians and Sarawakian PR, Work and Student Pass holders** who have been to **Mainland China, South Korea, Italy and Iran** in the last 14 days must undergo **COMPULSORY** home quarantine for 14 days. They will be subjected to random monitoring by the **Medical Authority**.
4. All visitors from COVID-19 affected countries and regions such as **France, Spain, Germany, United States of America, Japan, Singapore, Indonesia, Brunei Darussalam and West Malaysia** are to adhere to precautionary guidelines issued by the Sarawak Health Department at all Point Of Entry.

The above actions are taken as part of the Sarawak State Government's efforts and measures to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 into Sarawak.
